This IOC Women and Sport Congresses they have been a great opportunity for women around the world to cooperate and discuss things. I used to say in a very early stage in my life that if you want to reach something there is one very important motto, ‘ You have to be heard and you have to be seen’. Of course you have to have a great interest in leadership and of course for sport as well, and physical education. My dream was never to become a top elite sports woman, my dream was to become a good role model in physical education. So the basic has always been the voluntary sport movement, the equal



opportunities for everybody and also the opportunity for girl and women. Don't be afraid, you can, you are clever enough and you can also educate yourself and stand up and go forwards of your own dream .”
